Paid Summer Staff: This is a 6-week commitment (1 week of staff training, 5 weeks of camp) with a stipend pay of \$2,000. Summer staff consists of Cabin Leaders, and Program Staff. Cabin Leaders are responsible for 8-10 campers and will work with 3-4 Volunteer Cabin Counselors. Program Staff will plan and lead a specific program area (Arts & Crafts, Fishing & Boating, Discovery, Fun & Games, Pool, Horses, etc.).

Volunteer Counselors: This is a 1-week commitment, with the option of volunteering additional weeks. Volunteer counselors consist of both Cabin Counselors, as well as Program Counselors. Cabin Counselors will work with the Cabin Leader to create a safe, fun, and memorable experience for the campers in their cabin. Program Counselors will work with the Program Staff to implement the perfect plan for their program area.

Dream Team Volunteers: Our dream team volunteers help the food service manager and chef serve hearty and healthy meals to our wonderful campers. They set and clean up the dining hall before and after the meals as well as prepare the food that everyone enjoys during breakfast, lunch and dinner.

Medical Volunteers: The medical volunteers consist of both doctors and nurses who will work with our Medical Director and Nursing Director to create a safe and healthy week of camp.
